Inside Learning spaces

Follow instructions
Move carefully

Cooperate with, encourage and include others
Everyone has the right to learn

Whole body listening
Join in with learning
Hands up to ask questions
Stay on task
Learn from mistakes
Set and work towards goals
Keep your work space tidy
Practice learning qualities

Outside spaces

Use equipment correctly
Wear a hat for play
Walk around the school
Find staff help if needed

Respectful games
Care for the play equipment and play environment
Move quickly at the end of play
Play fairly

Whole body listening
Follow the rules of the activity
Report problems if they happen

Eating

Sit when eating
Walk only to eating and play areas
Follow staff instructions
Put lunchbox away
Eat your own lunch

Rubbish in the bin
Hand up after 3 whistles

Bring a healthy lunch
Wait for teacher's instruction to move to play area

Transitions

Walk between areas
Games stop at the end of playtime
Walk in lines with the class

Walk quietly around the school
Walk around the school
Wait for an adult
Be calm and patient
Rubbish in the bin

Put my belongings in the right place
Be on time

Toilets

Ask permission
Use toilet appropriately
Wash your hands

Respect privacy
Wait patiently
Leave the toilet area clean and tidy
Flush toilet
Quiet voices

Return to the classroom quickly
Report any problems to teacher
Go to the toilet and have a drink at the end of play

Church

Enter and exit calmly
Sit and stand quietly and carefully

Whole body listening
Sing and respond appropriately

Participate appropriately

Online

Check before entering details
Go to sites the teacher has approved
Turn off and report inappropriate images or words
Don't share personal information or images
Know who you are communicating with

Ask before you take a photo
Communicate in a kind and friendly way
Use equipment carefully
